Name of the position : Head of the Department (Tenure post of 5 years with Pay scale Rs. 1,44,200 – 2,18,200 (Academic Level 14) plus other allowances as admissible under the University rules)

Essential qualifications :

- Passed Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture /Community Science/Veterinary Science, as relevant to the requirement of the post.
- Secured minimum 55% marks or minimum Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) of 3.00 in 4 point scale or 7.00 in 10 point scale at the Master's degree level in disciplines of Agriculture/Community Science/Veterinary Science, as relevant to the requirement of the post from an Indian University or a foreign University.

Note : For universities adopting scales other than 4 point or 10 point, the minimum CGPA (MCGPA) requirement shall be worked out by the formula.

$MCGPA = 3 + 0.667 (\text{Scale Point} - 4)$. (Where, MCGPA = Minimum cumulative Grade Point Average, Scale Point= Highest value of the scale.)

(Thus, for 4,5,6,7,8, 9 and 10 Point Scales the MCGPAs are 3.00, 3.67, 4.33, 5.00, 5.67, 6.34 and 7.00, respectively when approximated at two places after decimal)

- Ph.D. Degree in any field of the concerned discipline.
- The candidate must have published at least 10 (ten) publications (research paper, book, chapter of book, review paper, monograph).
- A minimum score (45 out of 65) as stipulated in the 'Academic Performance Indicator' (API) based 'Performance Based Appraisal System'(PBAS).

Eligibility:

- Professor & equivalent in relevant discipline with 5 years experience should only apply.
- Other qualifications as for Professor(Stage 5) and equivalent

Desirable:

- Bagging and operating externally funded project either independently or as group leader.
- Up-to date knowledge in the relevant discipline and subjects within the discipline.
- Evidence of contribution to course curriculum development, introduction of innovative teaching methodologies etc.

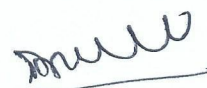
General Instructions:

A. Age is not a bar, up to a maximum of 63 years.

Note: The appointment will be for a tenure of five years or the incumbent attaining the superannuation age of 65 years, whichever is earlier.

B. Submission of application forms :

- i) Application form in prescribed format is to be submitted to the Registrar, AAU, Jorhat on or before 15th Aug, 2026.
- ii) The application fee is to be deposited at the State Bank of India, AAU Jorhat Branch (A/c No. 38509526536). For payment, make a demand draft in favour of Registrar , AAU. The prescribed fee is Rs. 500/- in case of general candidates and Rs. 250/- in case of SC/ST/PH candidates.
- iii) Applications received late and found incomplete will not be considered.
